



## Accomplishments 2017/18

1. 4CSD continued advocacy efforts in support of AB 2558. (Goal 1)
  - a. Participated on the Chancellor's Office Ad Hoc Task Force for Professional Development
  - b. In collaboration with the CCCCCO, participated in a letter writing campaign to support AB 2558.
2. 4CSD maintained a relationship with the Chancellor's Office through Dr. LeBaron Woodyard and Ms. Rita Levy. (Goal 1)
  - a. Invited Dr. LeBaron Woodyard to present at annual conference.
3. The successful 2018 conference attracted 90 participants. (Goal 3)
4. 4CSD advocated for professional development by encouraging and supporting 4CSD membership and participation. (Goal 1)
5. Institutional memberships increased to 40 (up from 31 in 2015/16) and individual memberships increased to three. (Goal 3)
6. Three 4CSD board members continue to serve on the IEPI (Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative) Advisory Committee and the Professional Development subcommittee, contributing to the development of the PLN (Professional Learning Network). (Goal 1)
7. *Professional Development for Implementing the Guided Pathways Framework* was a well-attended workshop presented at the 2018 4CSD conference. (Goal 4)
8. 4CSD supported colleges that are establishing new professional development programs and/or have a new coordinator in place. (Goal2)
  - a. The *Professional Development Practitioners' Workshop*, attended by 50 conference participants, was video recorded at the conference and uploaded to the PLN and 4CSD website.
  - b. The successful workshop, *How to Develop a Professional Development Program Plan*, was video recorded at the conference and uploaded to the PLN and 4CSD website.
